## City of Trenton – Public Notice

### Subject: Water Tower Repair and Temporary Citywide Water Conservation

The City of Trenton will be conducting necessary repairs and maintenance on the municipal water tower beginning **March 11, 2026** and continuing through approximately **March 20, 2026**. During this time, the tower will be temporarily taken out of service while crews complete structural and system improvements.

Because the water tower helps maintain pressure and reserve capacity for the city's water system, residents and businesses are **asked to conserve water citywide during the repair period**. Water service will remain operational, but conservation will help ensure adequate supply and stable water pressure for all customers.

Residents are encouraged to take the following steps during this time:

- Limit outdoor watering of lawns and landscaping
- Avoid washing vehicles unless necessary
- Run dishwashers and washing machines only with full loads
- Repair any leaking faucets or irrigation systems
- Reduce other non-essential water use where possible

These temporary conservation efforts will help the city maintain reliable service for homes, businesses, and emergency services while repairs are underway.

The City appreciates the community's cooperation and patience as we complete these important improvements to the water system.
